Focused Performance Improvement provides you with structured analysis of process breakdowns, followed by exploration of root causes contributing to process failure. You'll be able to develop targeted solutions to address those specific points of breakdown, assisted by JCI consultants who are trained in the methods and tools of Lean Six Sigma, the DMAIC (Define, Measure, Analyze, Improve, and Control) approach, and change management strategies.
